

11:00 A M Gupt Godawari Gufa

(Recommended time approx. 30-40 minutes.)
Gupt Godavari is a fascinating and sacred site located about 18 kilometres from Chitrakoot, steeped in both natural beauty and mythological significance. This unique spot is famous for its two cave system hidden within a mountain. The classical texts believe that Lord Rama and his brother Lakshmana spent part of their 14-year exile



12:00 PM Mata Ansuiya Ashram

(Recommend time approx.20 minutes.)

This ashram, known as a deeply revered site in Chitrakoot, steeped in mythological significance and spiritual history. It is believed to be the resting place of the sage Atri and his devout wife, Sati Ansuiya, who are venerated for their piety and devotion. The ashram is not only a place of meditation and spiritual reflection but also a site rich in stories from the Ramayana and other Hindu scriptures.





12:30 PM Sphatik Shila

(Recommended time approx. 10 minutes.) The Sphatik Shila is a sacred site located along the banks of the Mandakini River, just upstream from the famous Ram Ghat in Chitrakoot. This rock holds great significance in Hindu mythology and is celebrated by devotees for its deep connection to the life of Lord Rama and Mother Sita.



01:00 PM Ram Darshan Temple

(Recommended time approx. 20 minutes.)

The Ram Darshan Temple in Chitrakoot stands out as a unique and thought-provoking spiritual destination, unlike any other temple in India. This temple is distinct in its purpose and practices, as it focuses on imparting moral and cultural lessons rather than traditional worship.

The Kamtanath Temple is a Hindu temple located in the town of Chitrakoot, betwexed between the borders of Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh. The temple is dedicated to Lord Rama, who is worshipped here in the form of Kamtanath, a manifestation of the deity who is believed to fulfill the wishes of his devotees.

The Bharat Milap Temple, located along the Kamatanath Parikrama route in Chitrakoot, is a site of deep spiritual and historical significance. This temple is believed to mark the very spot where Bharat, the younger brother of Lord Rama, met him during his period of exile. The purpose of Bharat's visit was to convince Lord Rama to return to Ayodhya and reclaim his rightful place on the throne.



04:30 PM Hanuman Dhara Mandir

This Hanuman Temple, perched atop a massive rock in Chitrakoot, is a significant spiritual site that offers both a physical and spiritual journey for its visitors. The temple is dedicated to Lord Hanuman, the devoted disciple of Lord Rama, and it holds a special place in the hearts of pilgrims who visit Chitrakoot.



05:30 PM Ram Ghat

(Recommended time approx. 60 minutes.)

Ram Ghat is one of the most significant and sacred sites in Chitrakoot, located on the banks of the Mandakini River. Ram Ghat is not just a physical landmark but a spiritual heart of Chitrakoot, drawing pilgrims and visitors who seek to connect with the divinity of the place and immerse themselves in the tranquil ambiance of this holy town.
